New Properties Finders Fee

It is the policy of the WEGM to reward its members with a finders fee for locating new properties for the club to lease. The member will be paid \$240 or receive credit for \$240 in membership dues upon the club approving the lease for club use. The member must act as an agent between the landowner and the WEGM. To receive the finders fee, you must register in writing with the club secretary your intent to begin discussing a proposed lease with the landowner. You cannot receive the finders fee unless registration is complete and the lease is approved by the WEGM.

STANDING RULES

RULE OF THE MONTH:

1. ANY MEMBER CAN BRING ONTO THE PROPERTY A PERSON OR PERSONS (LIMIT TO SIX (6) THAT IS NOT A MEMBER. This person will be considered to be a guest and may participate in any club activities, while on the property with a member. If the member leaves the property, then the guest must leave the property. The member will be responsible for any damage caused by the guest.

A release of liability must be signed by the guest each time he visits the property. A Release of Liability form is on the back of the visit log sheet.

A guest cannot use their own motorized equipment. Guest may use a non-motorized equipment (pan, sluice) and members motorized equipment.

2. There is a limitation of six (6) visits in a twelve (12) month period of time. After the sixth visit, the guest must join the Weekend

Gold Miners Prospecting Club, Inc. or wait twelve month to return to the property. Former members must wait for a period of twelve months before visiting the property as a guest of a current member, provided the former member was not expelled from the club for violating club rules, regulation or by-laws, other than the non-payment of dues, then that former member may not come on the club property without approval from the Board of Directors.
